

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – April 14, 2021.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at 7:00 pm.

Audience: Don Nagel Scott & Trina Beltman

Roll Call: Members present – Tom Giles, Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by McLeod supported by Larsen, to approve the March Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board reported that he had a meeting last month and everything is going well with LIFE Ambulance Service. Transports are averaging approximately 72% and average response time is approximately 8 minutes. Nagel provided LIFE Care Ambulance membership applications.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station reported that DeYoung services is concerned that the dumpster placement is not stable. Dave Kemper dumped 20 yards of crushed concrete to stabilize these dumpsters.

Supervisor Giles reported that 116th bridge work is being set up but has not yet started and markings have been placed at 118th Ave. by the County. He also stated the DNR will now be reporting controlled burns to supervisors. There was some discussion about the Wilson property.

New Business: There was discussion regarding the County-Wide ORV Ordinance. Scott Beltman answered questions and explained what this ordinance would mean. After some discussion every Board member is in favor of this ORV ordinance and believe it would be very beneficial to the County and Townships.
