

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – January 10, 2018

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, January 10, 2018 at 7:30 pm.

Roll Call: Members present – Tom Giles, Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All Present

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen to approve the December Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: None

A motion by Larsen supported by McLeod to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by McKellips, that we pay the bills as presented. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

A **motion** by Ptak, supported by McLeod to adopt Burn Ordinance No. 68. An Ordinance to secure the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents and property owners of Clyde Township, Allegan County, MI. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

A **motion** by Ptak, supported by Larsen to reappoint Tasha Smalley of MTS as Zoning Administrator. Motion carried.

Public Comments: There was some discussion regarding a resident running a commercial recycling/junk yard business at his home. This is disturbing to neighbors who feel it will depreciate their property value and have to live with the burning smell and smoke.
