

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – July 8, 2020.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, July 8, 2020 at 7:30 pm.

Audience: Don Nagel, Bob Genetski.

Roll Call: Members present – Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak.  
Absent- Tom Giles.

A motion by Ptak, supported by McKellips that Bob Larsen run this meeting in the absence of Supervisor Giles. Motion carried.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, to approve the June Board meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: Cemetery Sexton, Mark McKellips sent in a copy of a violation letter for the Boards information.

A motion by Ptak supported by McLeod, to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by McKellips, that we pay the bills as presented. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Chris McKellips, Treasurer reported she has closed a Chemical Bank CD and transferred the money to the General Fund.

Bob Genetski, Allegan County Clerk addressed the Board. This is an Election year. August 4, 2020 Primary and November 3, 2020 General Election. He will be running again for County Clerk & Register of Deeds. He stated that he appreciates all the Clerks who will be conducting elections. He is very much against soliciting of AV Ballot Applications because this is against Election Law. Genetski submitted an update from the County Clerk's office and the Annual Report for 2019. Because the Courts are essential businesses the Court House has been open during COVID.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board stated that he is waiting for the Ambulance Contract but everything still looks good for August 1<sup>st</sup>. There was some discussion if LIFE will honor AMR supplemental insurance contracts. The answer is yes at least until April 2021. There was also some discussion as to why Clyde has so many calls with no transports. Nagel will look in to this.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station reported at his last meeting it was decided to raise prices.

New Business: Cathy Ptak, Clerk asked the Board to approve a new Laptop for Elections and to refurbish the old laptop to have as a back-up. A **motion** by McKellips, supported by Larsen, to approve a new laptop for the clerk and to have the old laptop refurbished and updated not to exceed the amount of \$1,500. Roll call vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

A **motion** by McKellips, supported by Ptak, to add Allegan Credit Union for our banking needs and to

approve McKellips to transfer money from Chemical Bank to Allegan Credit Union. Roll call vote- all aye's. Motion carried.

A **motion** by Ptak, supported by McKellips, that we re-appoint Bill Busscher to the Zoning Board of Appeals for another 2 year term. All aye's. Motion carried.

A **motion** by Ptak, supported by McKellips, that we re-appoint Donna Matula and Marlynn Starring to the Library Board for another 3 year term. All aye's. Motion carried.

No further business. A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, we adjourn.
