The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, June 12, 2019.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, to approve the May Board meeting minutes as written.
Motion carried.

A motion by Larsen supported by McLeod to approve the Treasurer's report as submitted. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, that we pay the bills as presented.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station reported that Dave Kemper has not filled in the holes in the drave way and repaired the gate that he was gong to do. Giles suggested McLeod call Scott Vanderlipp.

New Business: Ordinance No. 70 was discussed. This ordinance will amend the Zoning Ordinance No. 32 to add provisions for residential solar panels and commercial solar farms; add definitions; add farm market; amend roadside stand; amend accessory buildings in required front yard; amend animals; amend mining and quarrying operations; and to appeal all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflicct herewith. A **motion** by Giles, supported by Ptak, we approve and adopt Ordinance No. 70. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 71 was discussed. This ordinance will amend the Clyyde Township Zoning Ordinance (including the zoning map) by rezoning certain properties located in Land Section 4 from R-1, Rural Residential District to R-4, Lake Residential District and by rezoning certain other properties in Land Section 4 from R-1, Rural Residential District to R-2, Low Density Residential District, to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and to establish the effective date of said Ordinance. A **motion** by Giles, supported by Ptak, we approve and adopt Ordinance No. 71. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Julie Cowie of Casco Township Rural Gig Broadband Internet reported the Scenic View Dairy Tower is coming along for the main tower to send a signal to a portion of our residents. The Tower at Clyde township may not be tall enough because of the height of the trees in the area but they are still working on this. Julie Cowie met with Mary Whiteford and has requested funding for Clyde and surrounding area. Will possibly have more information in July.
